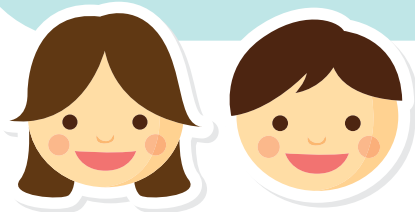


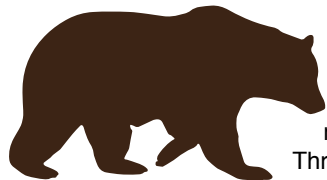
WHY WE FUNDRAISE

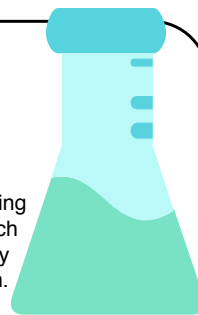
4TH GRADE TOPICS INCLUDE:
